JIA Traffic Advisory - Fri, Sept 16 - Sun, Sept 18

JIA has issued the following advisory for this weekends festival:

Traffic will be heavy entering and exiting Jekyll Island Friday, September 16, through Sunday, September 18.

Vehicles entering the island will be routed from Ben Fortson Parkway through the roundabout at Beach Village and north onto North Beachview Drive, continuing south onto Riverview Drive to the Jekyll Island Airport for Festival parking. Traffic exiting the island will be routed north of Riverview Drive, continuing on to North Beachview Drive, out to the roundabout, onto Ben Fortson Parkway, and back onto the Downing Musgrove Causeway. No traffic will be routed through residential areas.

Thank you for your patience and hospitality as we welcome 40,000 of our friends and neighbors to our beautiful island for this annual tradition.

The Jekyll Island Arts Association is pleased to announce an exhibit featuring the LowCountry Turners of Savannah and the coastal photography of Willard Smith beginning on Saturday, October 1st and will run until Monday, October 31st, at the Goodyear Cottage Art Gallery and Gift Shop located in the Historic District of Jekyll Island.

The LowCountry Turners of the Savannah metro area provide a meeting place for local turners to share ideas regarding this art and craft and to exchange recommendations for techniques, tools, design, and turning equipment. The group belongs to the American Association of Woodturners, and also provides encouragement to interested local youths.

Willard "Ryan" Smith completed his graduate work at the University of Virginia in the Spring of 2011 ("Wa-hoo-wa"). As replants to the Lowcountry, Ryan and his wife Marta re-launched their photography business in South Carolina, having opened it in Northern Virginia in 2008. The beautiful scenery of the area has offered great opportunities for them to expand their fine art gallery. In December of 2015, Ryan

began to use a technique called Intentional Camera Movement to create abstract imagery with his camera.

An artists' reception is planned for Sunday, October 2nd from 1:00 to 3:00 p.m. The Goodyear Cottage is open Monday through Friday from 12:00 to 4:00 p.m. and weekends from 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. As always, admission is free.
